



Bristol Met Uniform: How to get it right for September

When buying uniform items please do not be tempted to purchase it just because it is advertised as “school uniform”. Please check to see if it fits with the Academy Uniform brochure.

If in any doubt, keep the packaging and receipt for items purchased so that it can be returned or exchanged should it not be correct.

Check your uniform || Common mistakes

Skirts must not be stretchy and must be knee length.

Trousers must not be tight fitting (non stretchy material), and must cover the ankle and top of shoe.

Jean style trousers and material are not allowed.

Socks must be plain black, grey or white.

Shoes (all black) must have no logos or trainer type styling and compliment business dress.

Suede shoes are not permitted.

Jewellery

One small ear stud may be worn in each ear. Apart from this, for Health and Safety reasons and to promote the general business like values of the Academy, no jewellery may be worn. This includes rings, neck chains and facial piercings other than one 5mm nose stud.
